
Geir A. Siverstvik (Norwegian Telecom): Report from "ISDN Standard Applications at Lillehammer '94". letter, 3.4.1993

"Norwegian Telecom proposed, at the last IMIMG meeting in Rome, to establish a project team to use the XVII Winter olympics (Feb. 94) to focus on the four standardized ISDN applications, namely: simple file transfer (Euro file), telefax group 4, videophone based videoconferencing and 7 kHz audio.

The first project meeting was held in Lillehammer 9 and 10 February 1993. It was from Norwegian Telecom's point of view a very valuable and productive meeting.

Special focus was made on the necessity to perform interoperability testing between various products and different networks, especially for "Euro file" and TA's for eg. 7 kHz Audio equipment.

The group decided that international leaflets with information about ISDN equipment and availability at Lillehammer will be sent to all media delegates prior the '94 Winter Olympics. National leaflets with information about national ISDN equipment and availability from each country will be added. It was agreed that Norwegian Telecom will contact the project for the Euro ISDN opening, to present the idea of international service concept as a part of the Euro ISDN opening, and several other aspects that should be coordinated to gain mutual benefits. A specific document focusing on these aspects will be distributed at EIUF to the Euro ISDN opening meeting."
